

# Georgia Emergency Medical Services Information System (GEMSIS)

The Georgia Department of Public Health [Mandatory Reporting Requirements for EMS Agencies and Medics Rules and Regulations](#). All Georgia licensed EMS agencies (ground ambulance services, neonatal transport services, air ambulance services, and medical first responder services) must report EMS data using GEMSIS Elite v3.5.0 or any other NEMSIS-approved ePCR vendor software to be compliant.
